Spot zoning is...spot zoning--no matter the perceived “good” of the request. And I am not using “perceived” lightly.

Spot zoning is a very, very bad precedent and sets legal precedence for the future. You can lose control of the town very quickly when you open that barn door.

I lived in Falls Church, Virginia, for almost 40 years--a little town about six minutes from downtown Washington, DC. The city counsel allowed pipe stem zoning and before any of us knew what had happened, every available backyard big enough to support a house got pipe-stemmed--wiping out the “green” nature of the town in short order.

You have no idea how fast a zoning change can change a town.
